

# Roman Catholicism

## **Break the power of the following spirits:**

Fear, Spiritual Deception, Babylon, Mind Bondage, Occultism, Manipulation and Control, Divination, Matriarchal Witchcraft, Programming, Freemasonry, Idolatry, Sorcery, Guilt, Jezebel, Confusion, Buddha and Death from Buddha.

## **Prayer of Repentance and Renouncement:**

Father God, in the Name of Jesus I repent and renounce my participation in the (Roman, Greek or Russian) Catholic Institution. I take responsibility for my generations on both sides of the family for their participation in the Catholic Church. I cancel the effects of all promises that I made, all vows and oaths that I have taken. I repent and renounce all rituals, including the blessing of the throat with crossed candles and the prayer to St. Blaise. I ask forgiveness and that the curse be broken.

I renounce my allegiance to the Pope as the head of the one true church and to the Vatican as the Holy See. I renounce its yoke of bondage placed on me and my ancestors on both sides of the family. I repent of having had a fear of nuns and priests. I repent and ask forgiveness and that the curse be broken .

I renounce and repent of all belief and participation in the church's false doctrines; such as Mary as mediator between man and God. (1 Tim.2:5, Jn. 14:6 ); I repent Purgatory, and the praying to and for the dead,(Deut. 18:10-12) Salvation through works.(Eph, 2:8-9). I ask forgiveness and that all curses be broken.

I repent and renounce all the prayers that I prayed to Mary and to the saints. I renounce all dedications and consecrations that I did or that were done by others on my behalf. I repent and renounce believing that Mary was a virgin all her life. (Mt., 1:25, Mk.6:3) I repent and renounce having entertained a spirit of fear of excommunication. I repent and renounce any other fears that I took on from the Catholic Organization.

I break all spiritual ties between myself and the saints to whom I prayed. I also renounce the saints whose names I was given in Baptism and Confirmation. I break the power of those names.

I renounce the sacrament of infant baptism and the belief that it is one of the seven channels of grace through which I can hope for salvation.

I renounce all symbols and rituals in the sacraments of the Catholic Church.

I repent of having prayed the rosary and I renounce that devotion. (The rosary has its roots in Buddhism) I renounce all novenas and devotions to saints and I renounce all spiritual ties with them.

I ask that all curses placed upon me through the Knights of Columbus, Freemasons, Forresters and all Catholic societies and organizations be broken.

I repent of having relied on witchcraft for my protection. I repent of having worn scapulars and medals of different saints and of having believed in their promises, and indulgences. I repent of having used relics and of believing in their promises and indulgences .I repent of having participated in ceremonies and pilgrimages in honor of Mary and other saints.

I renounce the law established by the Council of Trent that stated that a penalty of death is upon those who do not believe the host is God incarnate. I ask Father that any curse upon me be broken. I confess that the host (wafer) and the wine is only symbolic. I renounce all that pertained to the " Eucharist" and I repent of the idolatry and worship, that I gave it under the belief that the eucharist (the host) was the Body of Christ and that the wine was the Blood of Jesus, I renounce the roots of the practice of adoring and paying homage to the exposition of the " Blessed Sacrament" and the worship of Baal. (The monstrance that the Eucharist was exposed in represented the sun god in Babylon.)

I repent for every Mass I attended and for believing the false beliefs within the structure of the Mass. I take responsibility for my generations on both sides of the family for their

participation and belief in all of this. I ask forgiveness and that any curse brought upon me be broken.

I repent and renounce any guilt that I may have entertained for leaving the Catholic Church.

(Break the power and cast out any evil spirits that came into the home because of religious articles brought into the home and very possibly venerated. (Suggest that they ask the Holy Spirit to guide them as to what to do concerning any of these articles still in their home). Return to page one and cast out all the evil spirits whose power you broke at the beginning of this session. Use this or any similar prayer to end the session:)

In the Name of Jesus, I command all evil spirits that have come out of this session to be gone from (person's name). Thank you Lord for healing all the wounds that might have been incurred while (person's name) was a member of the Catholic Church. I ask that You would mend the broken heart because of accusations, unforgiveness and guilt that she/he has entertained or has received from others.

(Make sure that the person repents and ask forgiveness for all of this. Break the power of these spirits and make sure that the person ask that the curse be broken.)

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(Ask the person to reflect a moment and repent and release any other spirits that may be interfering. The person may be feeling some self-hatred, anger or some discouragement at this time/. Give them time to deal with this.)

Thank the Father for the person's freedom and the victory that has been won.  
Release the person to the love and peace of Jesus.

Note : /if the person was a nun, brother or priest at one time have him/her renounce the vows of poverty, chastity and obedience and have him/her repent for having taken these vows. Deal with the curses and with the guilt. Break the power of the vows and cast out the spirits that might have entered them.
