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## Unloving Spirits

The Unloving spirit has a plan for your life, a plan to destroy you, all of you, body, soul and spirit. It brings torment to you as no other spirit is able to do. It prevents you from giving love to others or receiving love from others. Unloving is just the opposite of all that God has ordained you to be. You are to love God, love others, and love yourself. The unloving spirit's work is to separate you from God, from yourself and from others. It would then have you hate yourself and have you believe that God loves others but not you.

How does the unloving spirit find his way into your life? The unloving spirit works through all of the evil one's strongmen; particularly Bitterness and Rejection. If/when Bitterness or Rejection comes about in your life, somewhere down the road, you begin to reject yourself and feel bitterness toward yourself. This allows the unloving spirit to begin its work in your life. The Unloving spirit might be in your life because it was with your generations past and wants to continue its ugly work in you. Abuse may bring the Unloving spirit into your life. Maybe you have lived with another person who is full of the Unloving spirit and now you are saying and experiencing the same things.

What is an Unloving spirit? Unloving is that spirit who makes you feel you do not want to be touched, hugged, kissed, feel loved, feel accepted or receive any affection which would make you feel loved. He also does not want you to be able to give true love to yourself, others, or God. Here are some of the thoughts you might have if you have an Unloving spirit: "I am a loser; people do not like me and even hate me; God does not like me and even though the Bible says He does, that is only for others; I am unworthy; I hate myself." There's a hurt within that is not explainable.

What is a sign of the Unloving spirit's presence? Unloving is a very selfish spirit, always focusing you on yourself. Is it hard to care for others? Are you always talking about yourself, your needs and problems? Are you always centered on you; always selfish? The Unloving spirit is abusive and needs people to work out its personality of bondage; it goes further than self-rejection, hatred and bitterness. Unloving is double-minded and will drive you into perfectionism; you always striving for love and acceptance. In your personal life you experience self-bitterness, self-rejection, self-hatred; in the workplace you exhibit a false personality of self-exaltation, perfectionism, and the need to be number one. Many

who have an Unloving spirit will proclaim that they do not know who they are and have considerable confusion and disorientation.

In Mat 22:37-39 Jesus said to a Pharisee, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it, You shall love your neighbor as yourself." The Unloving spirit in your life would prevent you from loving, to prevent you from fulfilling God's command. This is the plan of the Unloving spirit; that he would defeat you in God's plan for your life. The unloving spirit will use many underling spirits to reinforce his position in your life. He is a liar and the father of lies. He brings a complete spiritual army so that you will be deceived and hooked into believing that the way you feel about yourself is just the way you are. You can be programmed into accepting the Unloving spirit into your life; by repeated verbal, physical or sexual abuse, you began to accept the lie that you are no good and just a big failure. Believing this lie will break your heart and cause not only your soul and spirit to fail but also your body. Our bodies are affected by what we believe about ourselves. (Proverbs 13:12)

**A Broken Heart.** Proverbs 17:22 says, "A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones." The bones and the bone marrow are the heart of your immune system; that is where the white blood cells are produced. Isaiah 61:1 indicates that Jesus came to bind up the broken-hearted. It says, "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound."

**Self-Pity.** One of the legs the Unloving spirit stands on is a spirit of Self-pity. This spirit will bind you to the past as if with super glue and not allow you to go on to the future. Accusing spirits will accompany Self-pity and hold you fast - into feeling so sorry for yourself that life no longer works for you.

The solution for an Unloving spirit in your life is God's love. In 1 John 4:18 it says, "There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear..." His perfect love will cast out the fear that the Unloving spirit has planted in you.
